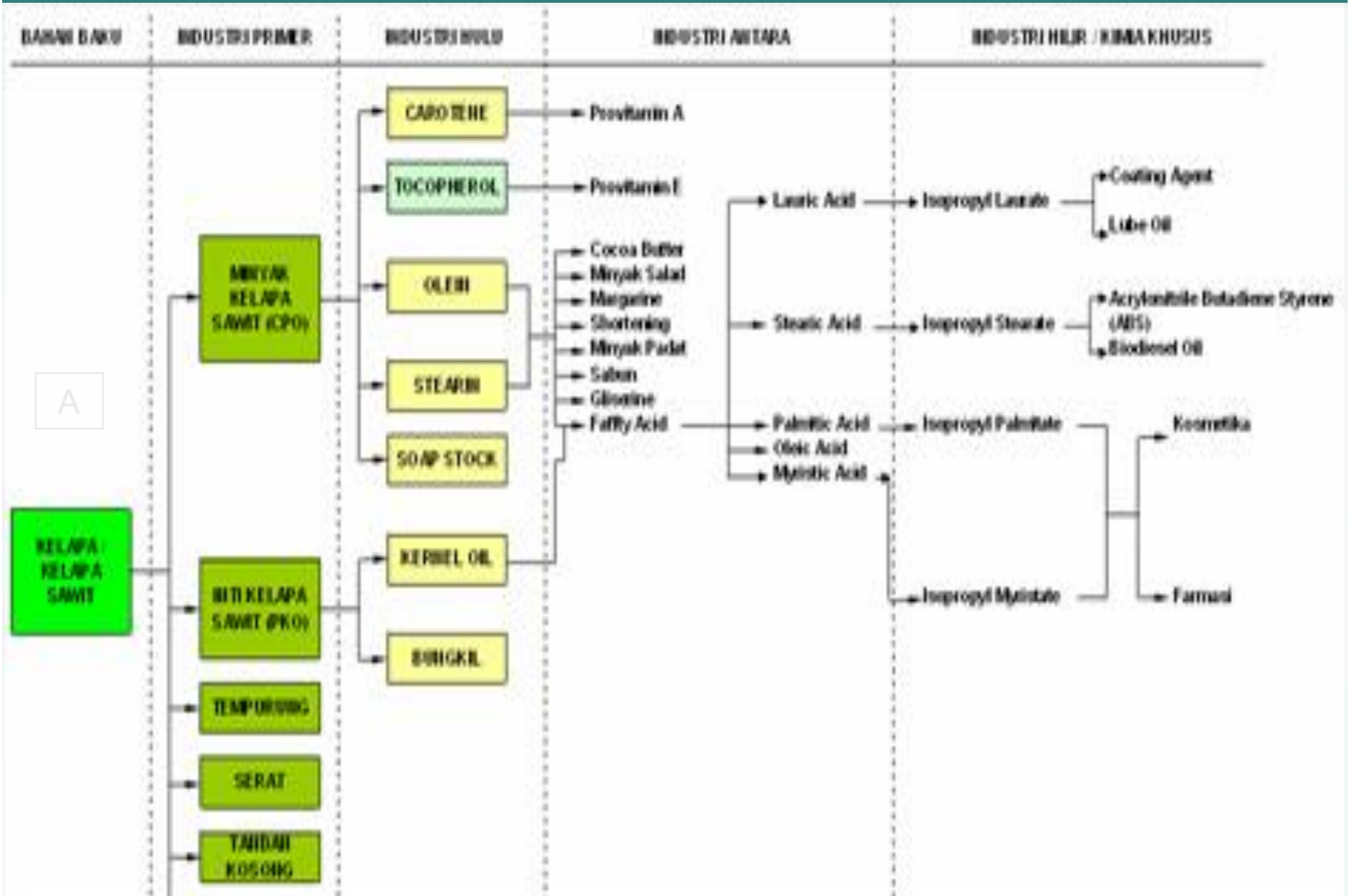
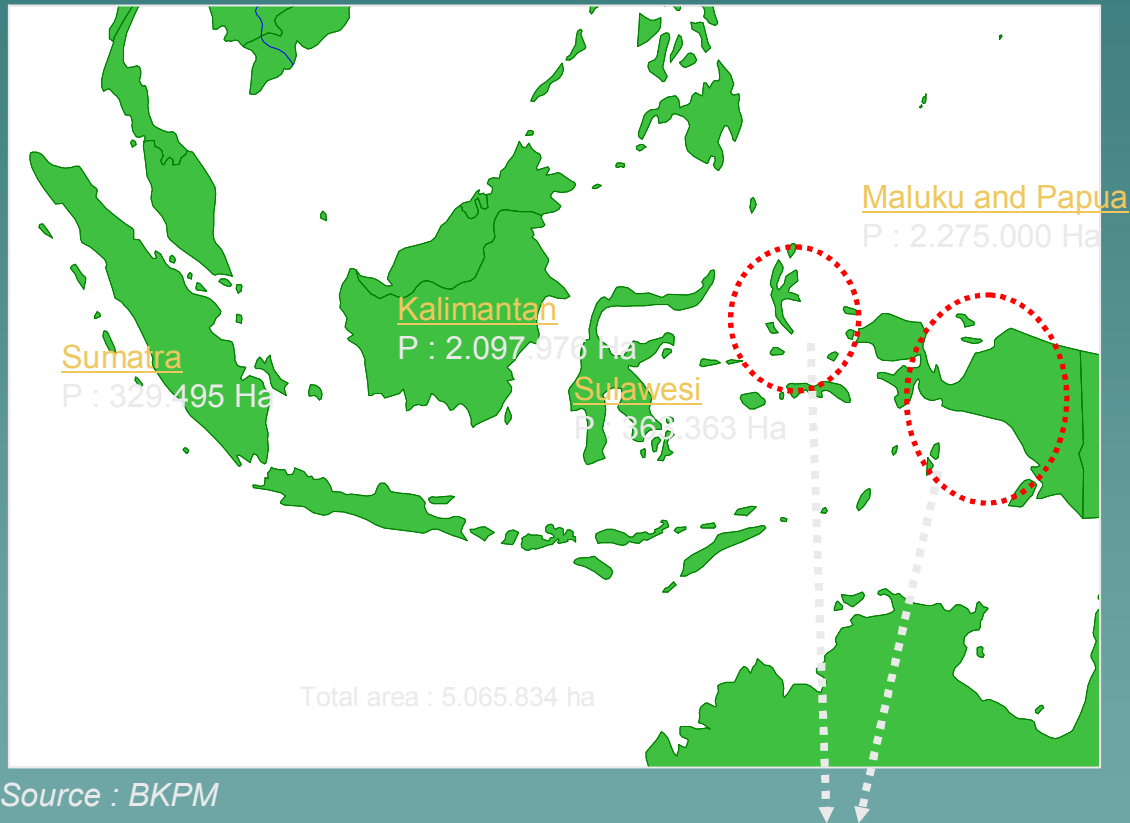

Potential Location

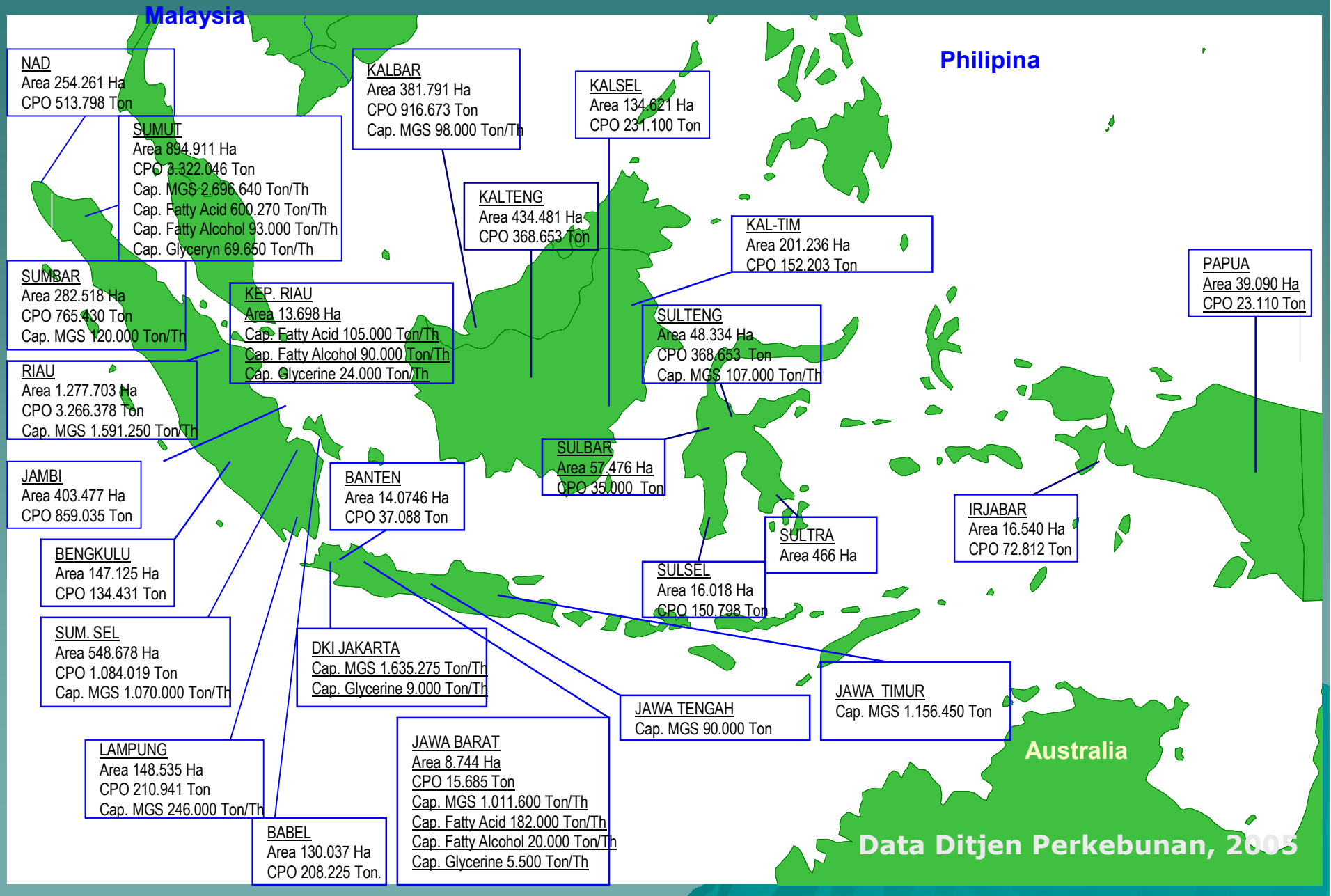


Employment

Alternative Location and Distribution of Existing CPO Industry (2005)



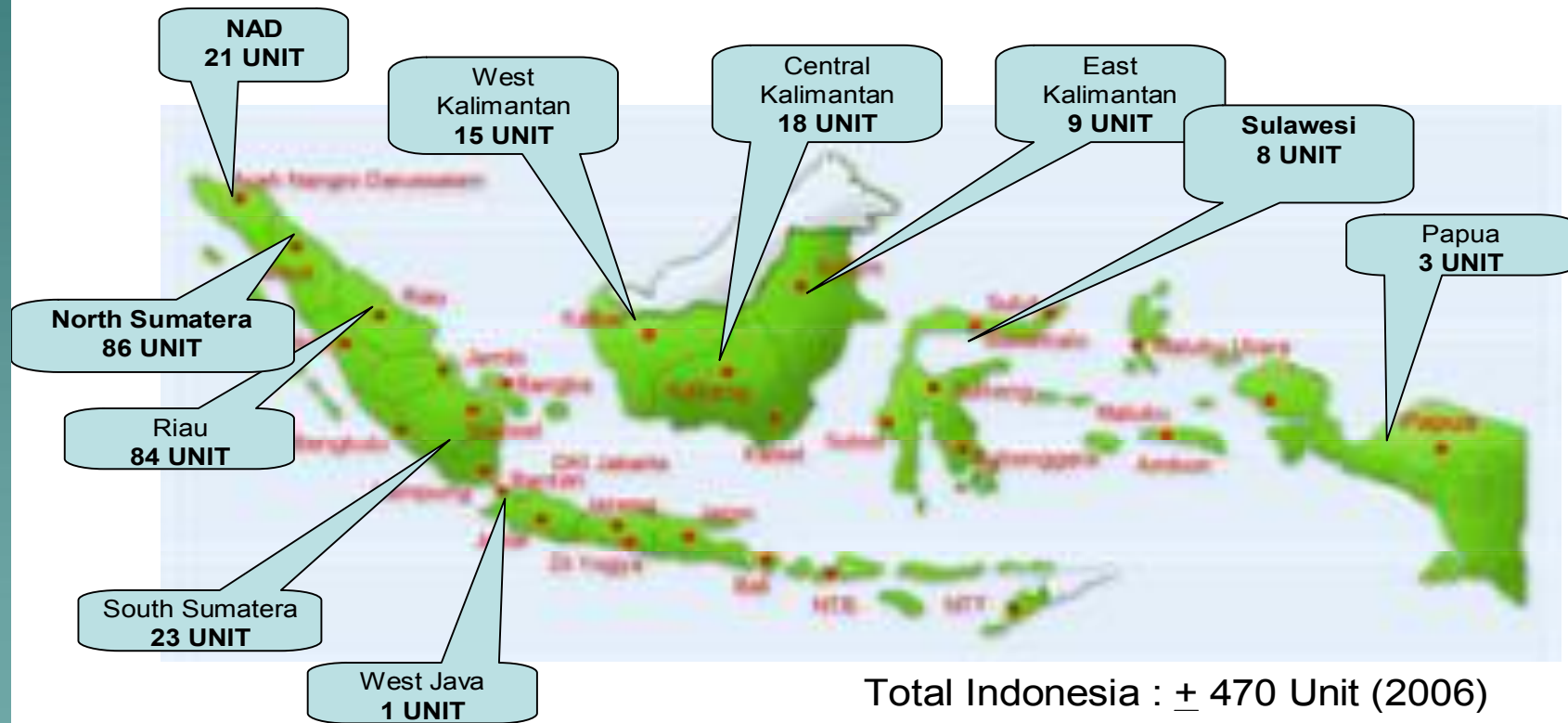
